Accessible access can be found on High Street.

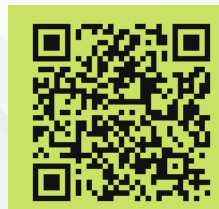

SPECIALIZED EYE CARE

- Experienced optometrists and dedicated student interns deliver top-quality care.
- Appointments last 1 hour, ensuring thorough measurements at a comfortable pace.
- Exam rooms are easily accessible for all individuals.
- Patients aged 3 through adult are welcome.
- Comprehensive vision exams are provided, even for non-verbal patients.
- Receive a detailed exam letter by mail with findings, recommendations, and accommodations for better everyday vision.
